



Coalition of Greater Minnesota Cities Conference Site Selection Process

A five-member conference selection committee (made up of four city representatives and one Flaherty & Hood, P.A. representative) will be appointed by the CGMC president. The committee will recommend a summer conference host city based on these guidelines:

1. The conference location will alternate between northern and southern cities. The 2010 conference is being hosted by Winona, so the 2011 conference will be in northern Minnesota.
2. Northern cities interested in hosting the 2011 conference must submit proposals containing hotel, meeting space, and local activities information to the nominating committee by August 6, 2010.
3. The city with the best overall proposal will be invited to host the 2011 conference.

The summer conference is typically hosted during the last week of July or the first week of August. If your city is interested in hosting this event, please complete the proposal form and return to Flaherty & Hood, P.A. by August 6, 2010. While cities are encouraged to work with their local tourism bureaus and hotels the actual proposal must come through the city itself.
